Answer Bank

- The Tennessee Valley Authority put thousands to work on construction projects.
- A moratorium was put on war debts to the United States so that Europe would be able to buy U.S. products.
- The National Recovery Administration was established to help businesses recover.
- The Federal Emergency Relief Administration loaned money to states for food, clothing, and shelter.
- The Emergency Banking Act made federal loans available to banks.
- Congress approved \$500 million to buy surplus crops from farmers.
- A federal public works program was set up to create jobs.
- The Reconstruction Finance Corporation was established to lend money to banks, insurance companies, and railroads.
- A national "bank holiday" prevented people from taking all of their money from banks.
- The Civilian Conservation Corps hired young people to plant trees, build roads, and help with flood control.
